
Yom Hashoah Commemoration

Robert Melson is Professor Emeritus of Political Science and Jewish Studies at Purdue University. He is a graduate of Yale University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology. His book, "False Papers: Deception and Survival in the Holocaust" is a memoir and was a finalist for the National Jewish Book Award in 2001. In 2003-2005, he was the President of the International Association of Genocide Scholars. He has lectured and written extensively on ethnic conflict and genocide.
